## *Internet Safety Guidelines for Teachers*



### Responsible

Define and practice procedures for how students handle technology equipment.

Teach students to create a positive digital footprint. Everything that is posted online is in permanent ink! Be nice!

Understand that you are responsible for monitoring students' internet use. Protect them by setting boundaries for where they go online.



### Ethical

*Model ethical behavior for students while using media sources. Give credit! Cite your sources!*

*Using a copy of someone else's photo, music or video breaks copyright law. Using other people's words as your own is called plagiarism.*

### Safe

Teach students to not share personal information online such as last name, address, birthdate, or phone number.

Model password protection for students. Keep your passwords safe. Do not allow others to use your passwords.

Remind students to tell an adult if something online makes them feel uncomfortable.
